3. Blackened Claws
Razor-sharp tools akin to those of Standing hunched on its strong hind legs, these claws are blackened with soot. If clean, I posit they'd look like magnesium because they, too, emit when struck agaisnt one another.
4. Fanned Tail
, tail that fans out to help the creature keep its balance. Top side is covered in much smaller, more flexible scales. Underside, like its head and underbelly, may be vulnerable to attack.
